Antoni Gaudi Cornet was a Catalan architect known as the greatest face of Catalan Modernism and has contributed to the most beautiful works of Spain.

Park Güell: Park Güell is a public park system located on Carmel Hill, in Barcelona, Spain.

Casa batllo: One of Gaudi's best work, Casa Batllo is a building in the centre of Barcelona. It is considered one of his masterpieces. This remodel is of a previously built house, was redesigned in 1904 by Gaudi.

Casa Milà: This modernist building, located in Barcelona, Spain is declared a World Heritage Site by UNESCO in 1984, This beautiful architecture has been the headquarters of the Fundació Catalunya La Pedrera Since 2013. Case Mila is also popularly known as La Pedrera or "The stone quarry". It was the last private residence designed by architect Gaudi and was built between 1906 and 1912.

*La Sagrada Familia: Basilica de la Sagrada Familia;
The breathtaking church of La Sagrada Familia is located in Barcelona, Spain. The masterpiece It's Been Under Construction for Over a Century. The project began in 1882 but Gaudi died in 1926, only a quarter of the basilica was completed. Gaudi spent his last few years dedicated to the project.
Though a long ways from being completed, La Sagrada Familia was designated as a UNESCO World Heritage Site in 1984. A lesser known fact for tourists is that La Sagrada familia is home to the tomb of Antoni Gaudi who wanted it to be built in a way that resembled nature.*



THE NATIONAL SPORT: BULL FIGHTING

Bull fighting is the national sport of the country and Many supporters of bullfighting regard it as a deeply ingrained, integral part of their national cultures. bullfighting is nicknamed la fiesta nacional or "the national fiesta".

During my time in Spain, I visited the famous, La monumental; The Plaza de Toros Monumental de Barcelona, located two blocks away from La sagrada familia. It is a non functional bull-ring where various remarkable fights took place. The place shelters "The Bullfighting Museum of Barcelona" and exhibits the fascinating costumes worn by famous bull-fighters, the heads of famous bulls, a collection of posters from the past, old tickets, photographs, documents and a library.
